Curriculum Process

From Kindergarten to Grade 12, our curriculum emphasizes structured learning, skill development, and experiential education.

The academic framework from Kindergarten to Class XII has been effectively transformed with a structured and progressive learning approach. Class K-5 ABL Method, 6 – 8, with an extensive curriculum, and class 9-12 as per the CBSE curriculum.

Digital platforms such as Playablo, Robotics, and Art-integrated learning through Rhapsody (Music Programme) sharpen students' creative and critical thinking skills.

The Design Thinking Curriculum introduced for middle school students encourages innovation and problem-solving.

At the secondary and senior secondary levels, Skill Education subjects such as *Artificial Intelligence*, *Financial Management*, *Physical Education*, and *Marketing* prepare students with essential life and career skills. The Financial Management Course for Class X, certified by the *National Stock Exchange, Mumbai*, aligns with the CBSE framework.

Our academic programs, combined with innovative assessments, aim to enhance understanding and empower students in their learning journey.

Programs like Spell Bee, Logiqids, and Olympiads nurture logical reasoning and a spirit of healthy competition among students. This year, initiatives such as HCL JIGSAW, Objective Type Test platforms from Extra Marks, and other integrated learning programs were introduced to enhance exposure and critical thinking skills. The school plans and executes a wide range of programs, projects, activities, and competitive exams throughout the year to ensure a continuous and enriching learning experience.

Various intraschool activities conducted throughout the year nurture global citizenship and holistic growth.

Annual project-based competitions — Inspired to Innovate and Mathenaeum — challenge students with advanced, real-world themes in Science and Mathematics.

Linguistic proficiency is developed through the Karadi Path, the LSRW Program for English, and the Dinamalar Pattam Editorial Competition for Tamil.

Tamil students learn Hindi as a compulsory third language till Class VIII, while Hindi students study Basic Tamil in Secondary School.

German is also offered as a hobby language for Class VI & VII, promoting multilingual development.

Value Education is an integral part of student learning.

Experiential learning is further enhanced through guest lectures, seminars, and other competitions across all levels, enriching conceptual understanding.

With schools today emphasizing holistic education, our vibrant school clubs have provided platforms for students to explore their interests, develop essential life skills, and learn beyond the classroom.

Parent Orientation Programs set clear directions for the academic process, while the Parent Teacher Meeting ensures that the students' requirements are well-discussed and efficiently implemented with the support of Parent Teacher Association representatives.
